John 2: 1-11

¹And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

²And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.

³And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine.

⁴Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.

⁵His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

⁶And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

Objective of Lesson:

Only God can perform Miracles. Just like turning water into wine, the miracle of the salvation is all of God.

Lesson Instructions:

1. Who here has been to a wedding? Raise your hands? Do you know what happens at a Wedding? It is when a man and a woman join together in a loving union and commit themselves to one another for their entire lives.
2. Today we are going to talk about a miracle our Lord performed at a wedding He attended. The Bible does not tell us whose wedding it was but we do know He ordained marriage for two people - a man and a woman - to be united.
3. Have you ever heard of a miracle? Do you know what makes something a miracle? It is an event that can only be performed by God. Nobody else can perform a miracle. Only God can. The Bible told us that when the Son of God comes to this earth He will have the ability to perform miracles. That is how we will know He is the Son of God.

4. Mary, the Mother of our Lord, had some friends in city called Cana. It was customary in those days to celebrate a wedding with a feast. Sometimes it lasted several days.
5. More people than were expected came to this wedding and they ran out of wine to drink. The hostess, I am sure was embarrassed. Mary heard about the trouble and she went to Jesus and said "They have no wine". Our Lord answered "What have I to do with thee woman. He told her "Mine hour is not yet come".
6. Mary accepted the Lords rebuke, realizing he could do as he pleased - and left it in his hands.
7. Mary said to the servants "Whatever He tells you to do, you do it..."
8. Near at hand there were six stone jars - about the size of a barrel. These barrels held the water for the household to use to cook and bath. Our Lord told the servants "Fill the waterpots with water." They obeyed filling them all the way to the top, till they could hold no more. Once the servants had done this He said "Pour some out and take it to the head of the feast".
9. This is the miracle - when they poured some out the water it had changed into fragrant, good-tasting wine.
10. Christ had performed the miracle. The servants secured the pots, filled them with water, poured it out - But it was Christ that performed the miracle and changed the water into wine.
11. This miracle is a picture of the miracle of salvation. Just like this miracle, salvation can only be performed by God. Sinners are empty, just like those clay pots were empty. The Lord commands the water to be poured into the pots. The Word of Truth is the same as that water. When it is preached - when it is poured out - all the sinner can do is receive it. Then by a miracle of God - the sinner is changed by the power of Christ and becomes a new creature. Just like the water was changed by the power of God into wine.
12. John 2: 11 - The beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth His glory; and His disciples believe on Him.


